Course Suitability:



CPR training is for everyone! We should all know how to save a life. This **CPR Training Course (HLTAID001 – Provide CPR)**, applies to all workers who may be required to provide CPR, in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. Specific licensing / regulatory requirements relating to this competency, including requirements for refresher training should be obtained from the relevant

national/state/territory Work Health and Safety Regulatory Authorities. This 'Unit of Competency' is **NATIONALLY RECOGNISED**.

This course is also a requirement for electricians to maintain licensing compliance and compulsory with an **Electrical License Renewal** application.

This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

As of November 2015, to successfully complete this unit of competency, the following performance evidence is mandatory:

- 1. The candidate must perform at least 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) (5 cycles of both compressions and ventilations) on an adult resuscitation manikin placed on the floor.**
- 2. The candidate must perform at least 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) (5 cycles of both compressions and ventilations) on an infant resuscitation manikin placed on a firm surface.**

Public Course Duration:

Alibi Training Australia (ATA) decisions about the duration of the delivery of each 'Unit of Competency' take into account the candidate's likelihood of successfully achieving the learning outcomes and ensures that the integrity of the qualification outcomes is maintained. ATA recognises that time-based approaches are imperfect measures of the quality of learning; however, there is evidence that the amount of time spent on a course can provide an indication of the quality of the course. National Centre for Vocational Education Research (NCVER), has Nationally Recognised nominal hours for 'Units of Competencies', ATA regularly advertises and delivers courses within less hours, based on the following:

- Although breaks are scheduled into the training, when they are taken, and the length is dependent on the clients attending the course.

- Many candidates must update CPR annually (Industry Requirements) and therefore only require refresher training, additionally in accordance with Australian Resuscitation guidelines First Aid qualifications should be re-certified every 3 years, therefore refresher training is required.

What will you learn?

- Identify hazards to health and safety of self and others.
- Minimise immediate risk to health and safety of self, casualty, and others by isolating any hazard(s)
- Approach the casualty in a calm, culturally aware, sensitive, and respectful manner.
- Assess vital signs of casualty.
- Recognise the need for CPR.
- Perform CPR in line with ARC Guidelines.
- Seek assistance from others and/or ambulance support as appropriate.
- Request ambulance support or appropriate medical assistance and/or ambulance support using available means of communication.

- Accurately convey details of casualty's condition and CPR procedures performed to emergency services/relieving personnel.
- Calmly provide information to reassure casualty, adopting a communication style to match the casualty's level of consciousness.
- Provide reports, where applicable, in a timely manner, presenting all relevant facts relating to performing CPR according to established procedures

Pre-requisites:

- There are no entry requirements for this qualification; however, it is recommended that students have enough Language, Literacy & Numeracy (LLN) skills to successfully complete the required theory & practical assessment process.
- Participants must be over 14 years of age or have written parental/guardian consent to attend.

Assessment Method & Award Issued:

Participants who satisfactorily demonstrate competency in both our theory and practical assessments will receive a **Statement of Attainment – 'Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation – Unit Code HLTAID001'**, that is **normally valid for one (1) year** in line with ARC guidelines. This course relates to the Health Training Package.
